Notice to Commission Certificated Motor Carriers:

At the August 8, 2007 public meeting, pursuant to Section 510 of the Public Utility Code, 66 Pa. C.S. §510, the Commission approved assessments upon public utilities for the 2007-2008 fiscal year. However, due to recent judicial and legislative developments, the bills for transportation public utilities will be delayed pending evaluation. Attached is an Important Notice concerning registration under the Unified Carrier Registration program. This Notice applies only to Motor Carriers operating commercial motor vehicles in interstate commerce. Please read the notice very carefully, and, if applicable, complete and return the form to the Commission before November 1, 2007.

IMPORTANT NOTICE
Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission (PUC)
Informational Update Needed

Effective January 1, 2007, the Unified Carrier Registration (UCR) Act, 49 U.S.C. §14504a, requires motor carriers, operating commercial motor vehicles¹⁸⁸ in interstate commerce, to register under the UCR Act and pay fees based on the size of their fleet. Pennsylvania, through the PUC, will participate in the UCR program beginning January 1, 2008. After this date, PUC assessments will **not** be made against qualified operations of UCR carriers.

You are **directed** to advise the PUC whether you operate commercial motor vehicles in interstate commerce and are therefore required to register under the Federal UCR Act.

If you operate a commercial motor vehicle in interstate commerce, complete the following:

¹⁸⁸ A "Commercial Motor Vehicle" is defined as a self-propelled or towed vehicle used on the highways in commerce principally to transport passengers or cargo, if the vehicle:

- (a) has a gross vehicle weight of 10,001 pounds or more;
- (b) is designed to transport 11 or more passengers (including the driver); or
- (c) is used in transporting hazardous materials in a quantity requiring placarding.
